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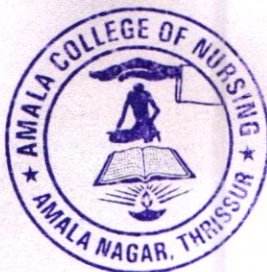

##### Admission:

Classes for 17<sup>th</sup> batch of B.Sc. Nursing and 10<sup>th</sup> batch of M.Sc. Nursing started on March 08<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Only those students with 100% index marks got admission in merit seats. Admission to 18<sup>th</sup> batch of B.Sc. Nursing were completed with the lowest index mark of 100%. Amala College of Nursing was the first preference for all admitted students (100%). Five candidates were enrolled for Ph.D. (part time) in 2022 with highest number of PhD enrollment.
