ACTION TAKEN REPORT

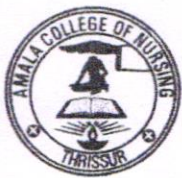
- ❖ Syllabus orientation to be given at the beginning of academic year by course coordinators

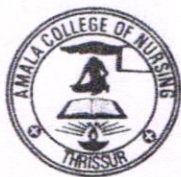
MASTER PLAN
