
REPORT ON WORLD GIRL CHILD DAY CELEBRATION





Women's Equality Day has been celebrated annually on August 26. The celebration falls on the anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment which granted women the right to vote.




On 26/08/2022 an awarness session was organized in Amala College of Nursing to recognise the women's right. The session was based on the theme"Hard Won...Not Done'.




1. SOCIAL ADVOCACY SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME- DOWRY AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN




