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AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

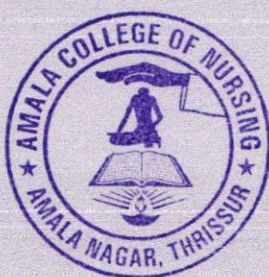
AIMS

This programme is intended to

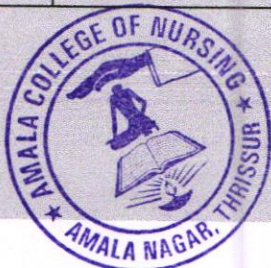
- To facilitate the development of a holistic perspective among students toward s life and profession as well as towards happiness and prosperity based on a correct understanding of the human reality and the rest of existence.

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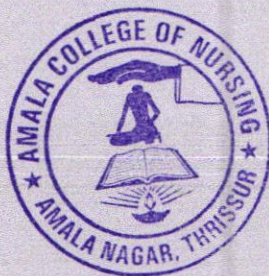

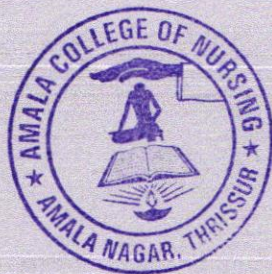

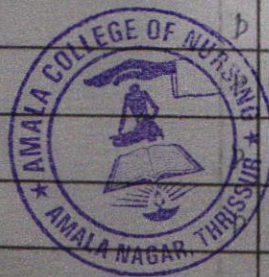
