DECLARATION BY PRINCIPAL

Hereby declare that admission of students at Amala College of Nursing, Thrissur to reservation categories are according to following guidelines and orders:

1. As per the agreement between Association of the Managements of Christian Self Financing Nursing Colleges of Kerala (AMCSFNCK) and Government of Kerala, 50% of B.Sc. Nursing and 50% of M.Sc. Nursing seats are filled up by the Government in accordance with allocation policy (25 no seats). Management seats are filled by AMCSFNCK on merit basis. Reservation is applicable for government seats.
2. As per reservation principles 40% seats in the Government quota are reserved for reservation categories (10 seats in B.Sc. Nursing and 2 seats in M.Sc. Nursing).
3. As per minority status of Amala College of Nursing, 20% of the Government seats are filled up from candidates belonging to minority (Christian) community (5 seats in B.Sc. Nursing).
4. Lapsed seats in community reservation if any are filled by candidates on merit basis by Government.
