Teaching Methode :Jigsaw technique

The **jigsaw** technique is a method of organizing classroom activity that makes students dependent on each other to succeed.. It breaks classes into groups that each assemble a piece of an assignment and synthesize their work when finished.

The technique splits classes into mixed groups to work on small problems that the group collates into a final outcome. For example, a topic divided into topics. Students are then split into groups with one member assigned to each topic. Working individually, each student learns about their topic and presents it to their group.

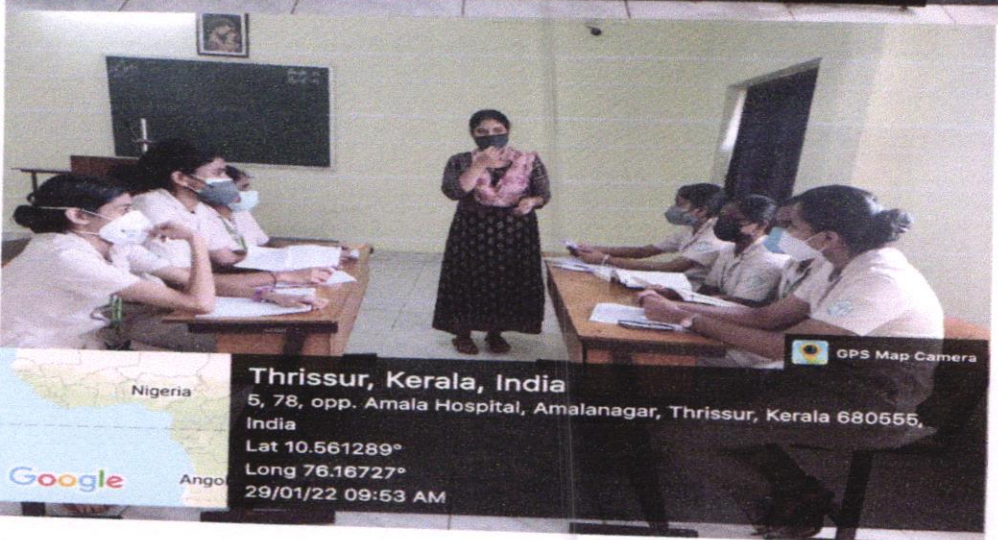
