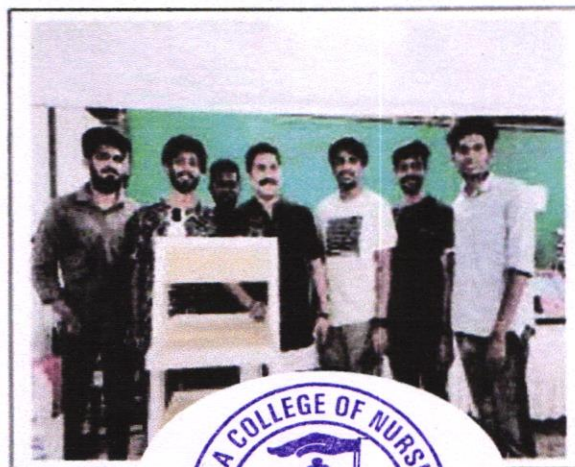
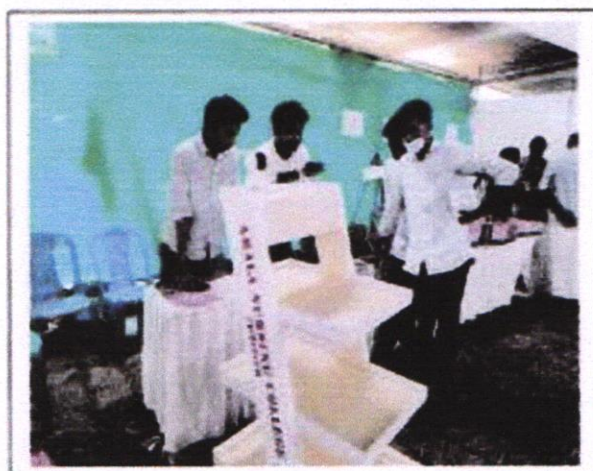
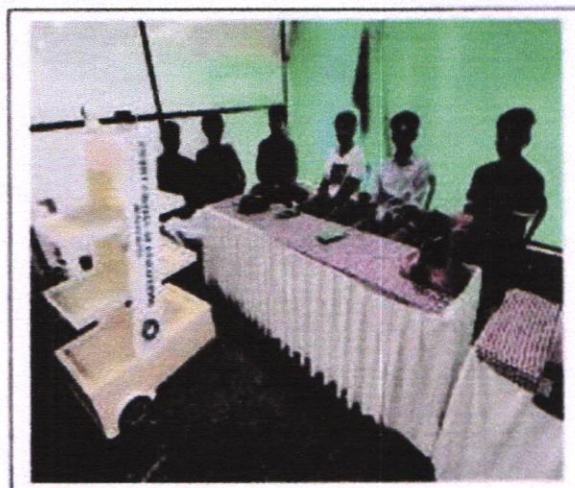

REPORT ON INVENTION OF ROBOTIC DEVICE IN COLLABORATION WITH CHRIST COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, IRINJALAKUDA Nightingale Robot-Aro Mithra

Amala College of Nursing 2nd year B.Sc. students in collaboration with students and faculty of Christ College of Engineering, Irinjalakuda participated in science expo held on 02.04.2022 and 03.04.2022 organized by CPIM party congress at Dharmashala, Kannur. During the expo we displayed our collaborative robotic device developed as a part of MOU. This invention seems to be a milestone achievement in the history of our college. This robotic device featured for medical purpose, its working under remote control, fully GPS programmed with reusable battery charging facility, for controlling - it has a 360° CCTV camera attached to a minitab for visualization. It works in power of 12 volts, smoothly works in flat surface with a sensor to identify obstruction. Main purpose of this inventive device is for transportation of medicine, linen, food, monitoring of patient, especially focused for isolation wards. 10 other colleges participated in the expo with variety of innovative products. Budgetary expense around 75,000/- spend for the product generation. 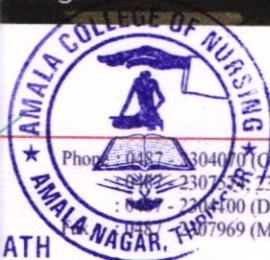
COLLABORATIVE ACTIVITY WITH CHRIST ENGINEERING COLLEGE ON 21/3/2023
