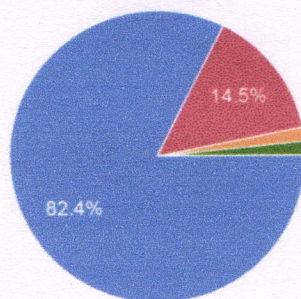

1) How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

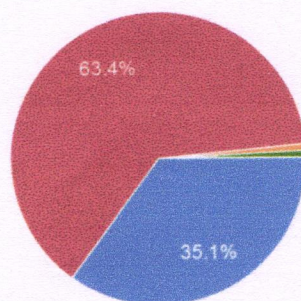

2) How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

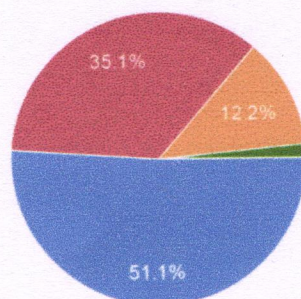

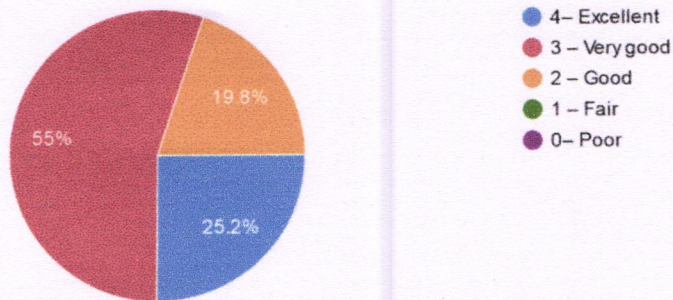

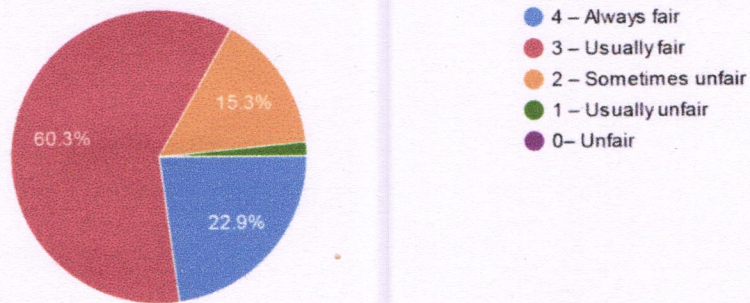
4) The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

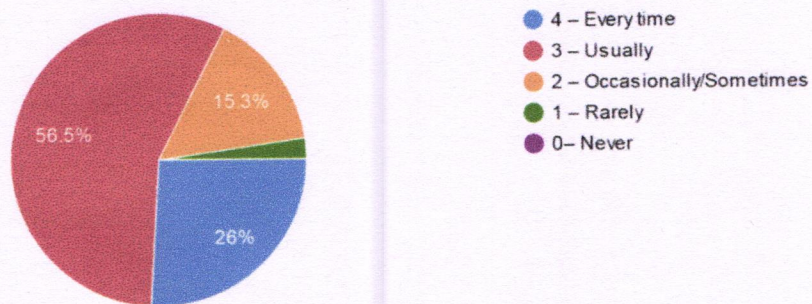

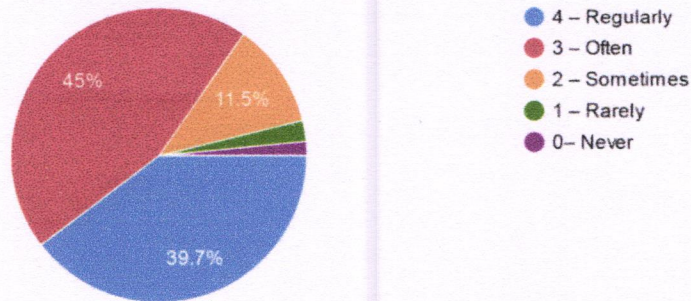

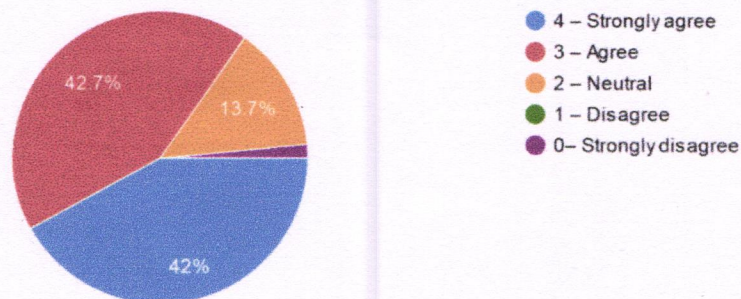

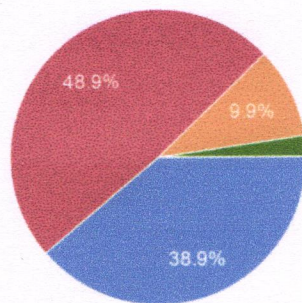

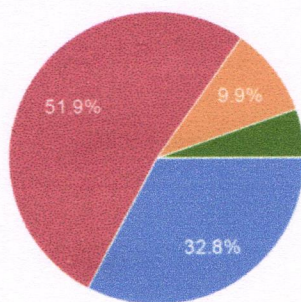

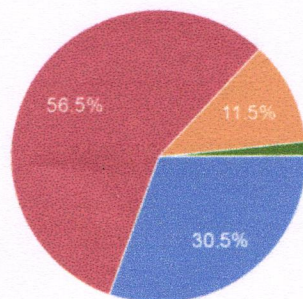

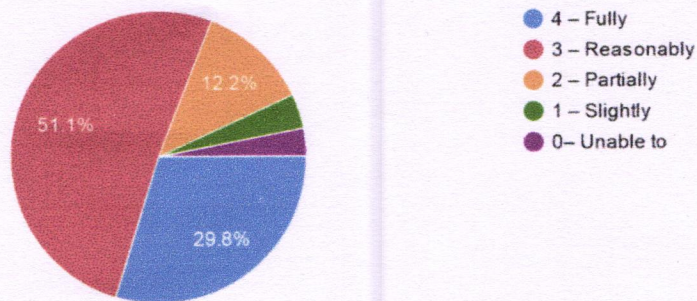
