- 2. Ethical committee shall decide on the consent to be taken or its agreement based on the degree of risk that may be involved
- Non exploitation of research participants irrespective of their social and economic condition or education levels
- 4. Identity and records of the human participants involved in the research are kept confidential
- 5. Due attention is taken at all stages of the research activities to ensure that the research participants are put to the minimum risk
- 6. Research is conducted by competent and qualified persons who act with total integrity and impartiality.
- 7. Research will be conducted in a equitable honest, unbiased and transparent manner.
- 8. All institutional arrangements required to be made in respect of the research and its application is duly made in a bonafide and crystal clear manner. All appropriate steps should be taken to ensure that research reports, materials and data connected with the research are duly preserved and archived.
- 9. Research must be brought to the public domain so that its results are generally made known through scientific and other publications. 10. The effect of the research is duly monitored and constantly subjected to review and remedial action at all stages of the research for its future use.

Institutions believe that, to monitor all these principles of ethics in research done by teachers and students of this college, an institutional ethical committee is needed. All research done in this institution should be screened by IEC which is formulated and registered according to the guidelines of ICMR.

RESEARCH POLICY

PREAMBLE

Faculty are required to participate in research, publish their work participate in research, publish their work and participate in national and international conferences, to present the research data and generate new concepts in the emerging areas.

AIMS OF THE POLICY

- 1. Provide guideline for the publication of the research work.
- 2. Define and prioritize the areas for research to be conducted in the Amala College of Nursing.
- 3. Provide essential research logistics for the research work.
- 5. Promote and motivate faculty members for the research activities.
- 4. Establish rational, transparent, outcome based, decision making systems for the allocation of financial and other support for research projects.

- 2. There should be an ethical committee constituted and functioning as per the guidelines of government of India.
- 3. The ethics committee should be registered and it should fulfill other legal requirement.
- 4. There should be a central statistical and research unit for continual support for the research.
- 5. Authors can select any suitable journal for the publication of their work.
- 6. The research in the Amala College of Nursing should be aimed towards:
- a) Contribute to the evidence based comprehensive health management.
- b) Critical Review of the global evidence based its adaption for local conditions.
- c) Generate baseline health data required for planning, implementation or evaluation of health services.
- d) Provide necessary data to establish linkage between health research and National Health Programmes by conducting operational research.
- e) Facilitate basic research for the promotion of health care and commercially used affordable products for society needs.
- d. Facilitate the development of fundamental research in the areas relevant to Health Sciences.
- 7. The researchers should be encouraged to seek the funds for their projects from external funding agencies.
- 8. There should be a research and institutional ethical committee for each faculty to guide and monitor the research activities periodically to enhance the quality of research.
- 9. The faculty and post graduate students should be encouraged to attend state, national and international conferences and present their work in these conferences, using posters, preferably by oral presentation.

10. There should be a mechanism for funding the faculty and post graduates.



ORDER

Kerala University of Health Sciences had invited application from the affiliated colleges to be recognized as PhD research centres of KUHS as per the notification read as (1) above. On the basis of the applications of the 42 institutions from various departments to be recognized under KUHS, a scrutiny committee had constituted to examine these applications and selected 36 research centres as per the paper read as 2nd above for inspection. An inspection committee had also constituted as per the order read as 3rd above and it conducted inspection at the institutions and recommended approval of 29 institutions for conducting PhD programme under KUHS.

The Academic Council has approved the recommendations of the scrutiny committee and 29 research centres selected to be registered as recognized under KUHS. In compliance to the decision of the Academic Council as per the paper read as (5) above, the Governing Council has approved the minutes as per the paper read as (6) and the decision was implemented.

In the circumstances sanction is hereby accorded by the Vice Chancellor, in exercise of his powers under section 12(7) of Kerala University of Health Sciences Act 2010, the recognition of the following 29 Institutions as research centres under Kerala University of Health Sciences for pursuing the studies for PhD programme.
