#### Report of field visits Second year BSc Nursing 2022-2023

#### 1. Report on visit to urban health centre

As a part of community health nursing positing second year BSc nursing students had an opportunity to visit an urban health centre located at Patturaikal on 13 October 2022. The urban health centre is under Amala Medical College Hospital, Community medicine department. The working hours is 9:00am – 4:00pm. Students were given an orientation by the health centre staff and also visited the laboratory and explained about various blood and urine tests that are used to check in UHC. Health inspector explained about the different medicines that are available in PHC. Also, they showed them about important records and registers of UHC.

#### 2. Report on visit to Rural health centre

As a part of community health nursing positing second year BSc nursing students had an opportunity to visit an rural health centre located at Kallur on 26 October 2022. The rural health centre is undertaken by Amala Medical College Hospital and known as St. Joseph hospital. The institution is functional for 24hrs. Students were given an orientation by Mrs. Santhakumari and also explained about their activities and services. They got a clear cut idea the establishments, physical setup, staffing pattern, functions and programmes of a rural health centre.

#### 3. Report on field visit to Water Purification Plant Peechi

An observation visit was organized to water purification plant at Peechi for second year BSc nursing students to meet the requirements of their curriculum on 15 October 2022. The group reached there at 10:30 am and the dam operator explained about water purification plant. The main objective of the visit was to identify components of water purification system, various techniques of storing water, filtration process, functioning of slow sand and rapid sand & also process of disinfection. They had given knowledge about standard and criteria for water quality, water purification, method of chlorination of water. Students were given time to watch around the plant and returned back to college by 2 pm.

#### 4. Report on field visit to slaughter house

As a part of Community health practical's 50 students visited the slaughter horse at Kuriachira. They had visited as two batches on 21/10/22. This slaughter house is running by the Thrissur, Municipal Corporation. Mrs. Veena, veterinary of the slaughter house explained about the organization and working of the slaughter house. She also shared her experiences of features observed during antemortum and postmortem examination. They also explained about the efflurent treatment plant (ETP) which is employed in recycling blood and water waste obtained during slaughtering process and this water is recycled and used for agricultural activities.

At present there are over 170 children in 17 family who are living under the care of 11 SOS mothers, two SOS aunts and six mother trainees.
