 - 3.1.1 Collaborative development of online courses for students especially related to health, hygiene, geriatrics etc.

 - 3.1.5 Interchange and/or exchanges of staff and students;

Each party shall use its reasonable endeavours to prevent the disclosure of any such confidential information.

5. Termination


5.1 Each party may terminate this MOU with 30 days' notice in lieu of writing to the other party.

Collaborative activity report with Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous)


