



REPORT ON NUTRITION CARE PROCESS

Amala College of nursing in collaboration with Vimala College has made an MOU. Mrs Anupa Joy, Asst Professor, Dept of Home science from Vimala college has taken a class on nutrition care process for I year BSc nursing students on 4/5/22 at 2.00 pm. The session mainly discussed on nutrition assessment, nutrition diagnosis, nutrition intervention, nutrition monitoring and evaluation.



The Nutrition Care Process (NCP) is a systematic approach to providing high quality nutrition care. The NCP consists of four distinct, interrelated steps: The registered dietitian nutritionist, collects and documents information such as food or nutrition-related history; biochemical data, medical tests and procedures; anthropometric measurements, nutrition-focused physical findings and client history. Data collected during the nutrition assessment guides the registered dietitian nutritionist in selection of the appropriate nutrition diagnosis. The registered dietitian nutritionist then selects the nutrition intervention that will be directed to the root cause of the nutrition problem and aimed at alleviating the signs and symptoms of the diagnosis. The final step of the process is monitoring and evaluation, which the registered dietitian nutritionist uses to determine if the client has achieved, or is making progress toward, the planned goals.

The students actively participated and cleared their doubts during the session. In continuation with it series of sessions were planned. The session ended at 4.00 pm.



Our knowledge regarding the complicated physiology of nutrition is incomplete and nutritional regimens vary widely between individual centers. There is no consensus regarding the optimal timing, route, amount and composition of nutritional support for burn patients, but most clinicians advocate for early enteral nutrition with high-carbohydrate formulas. Severe burn causes significant metabolic derangements that make nutritional support uniquely important and challenging for burned patients. A multidisciplinary approach to burn management is essential to optimal functional and cosmetic outcome.
