ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF ANTIRAGGING 2022-2023

The first Antiragging committee meeting for the year 2022-2023 was held on held on 02.03.2022 at Conference Hall of Amala College of Nursing at 1.00 pm to make strategy plan to avoid ragging prior to the arrival of first year B.Sc.
