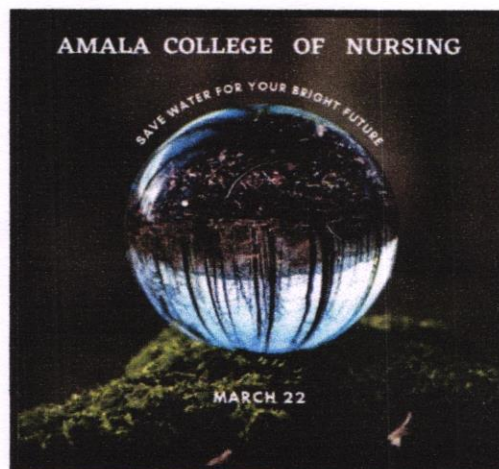


Image 1: Brouchure of World

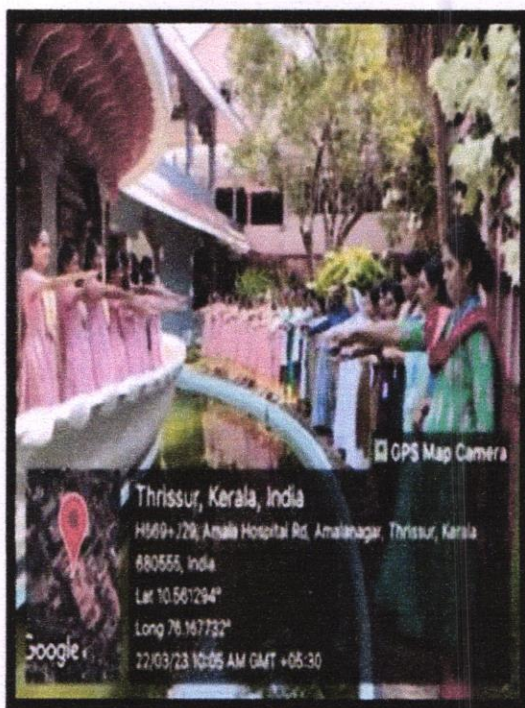


Image 2: Photograph of pledge taking

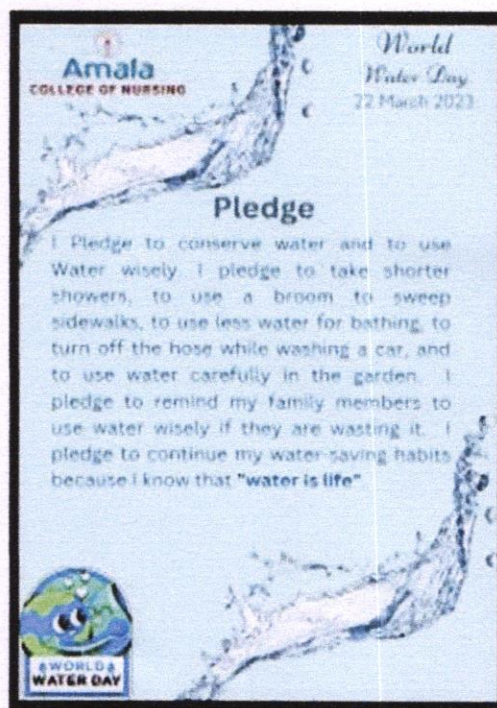


Image 3: Pledge

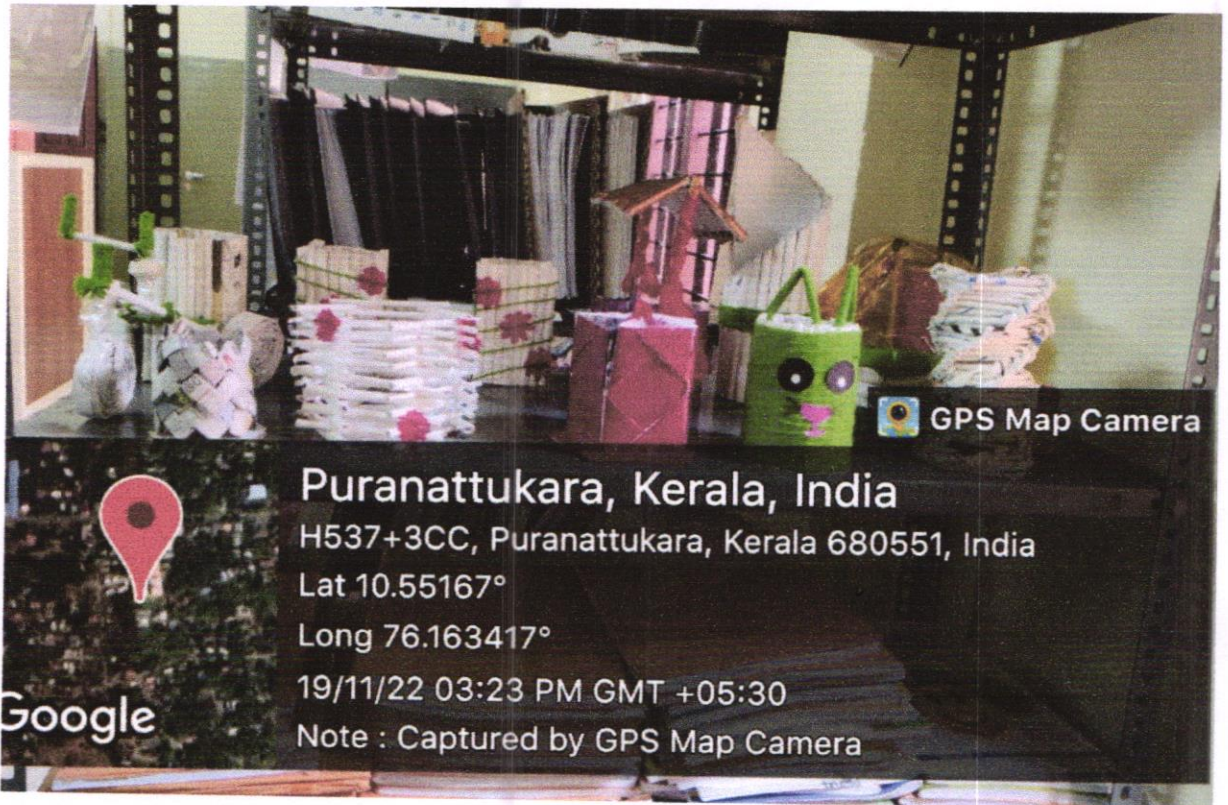
